Information About Cycle Training

We are able to take complete beginners or those that can already ride.

- Level 1: This is taught somewhere off-road like a playground or park.
- Level 2: We will go to quiet residential streets where you will begin to learn about side roads, how to pass parked cars and road positioning.
- Level 3: This level is meant for more advanced cyclists.
