

Case Study: The Packaging Company (Midlands) Limited

Lighting Installation: 21 May 2015

The Packaging Company (Midlands) Limited is a packaging supplier located in Braunstone Frith Industrial Estate, Leicester. They offer packaging solutions to businesses in the East Midlands.

The Packaging Company (Midlands) Ltd initially contacted Leicester City Council regarding support to help reduce their energy use, and thus decrease their utility bills.

During the initial site visit, it was highlighted that the lighting in the warehouse could be improved to increase energy efficiency.

The Packaging Company (Midlands) Ltd saw an opportunity to save money on their electricity bill through changing the old eight-foot T12 fluorescent tubes with energy efficient Hilux Low Bay Fittings which includes 4x55W PL lights.

Therefore, The Packaging Company (Midlands) Ltd contacted David Young about the Carbon Management for Leicester SMEs grant, to enable them to improve their energy efficiency.

The Packaging Company (Midlands) Ltd was awarded £1,000 towards the supply and installation of the energy efficient lighting in the warehouse.

The Packaging Company (Midlands) Limited is predicted **to save up to £340 and 1262 kgCO₂ per year** by replacing the old inefficient T12 fluorescent tube lights with the new PL lights.
