

Matter 1 Written Statement: Willoughby Waterleys Residents Association (297)

Despite the signing in late 2023 of the Statement of Common Ground for Allocation of The City's unmet Housing Need, by Harborough District Council (HDC), the Duty to Co-operate has not been complied with. By The City's own words "non-compliance with the DtC cannot be rectified after the submission of the Plan". The Plan was submitted three months prior to HDC signing! By Leicester City's own admission therefore the DtC has not been met. We would also re-iterate that the SoCG is flawed. It was prepared without consideration of the necessary (as identified previously by all Authorities in the County) reports relating to Strategic Transport Assessment and the Growth Options and Constraints Mapping Report.
