THE LEICESTER (CONSOLIDATION) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2006 (AMENDMENT) (CHARLES STREET) LEICESTER (NO...) ORDER 2024

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Leicester City Council (the Council) in exercise of their powers under Section 1, 2, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police intends to make a Traffic Regulation Order.

It is therefore proposed that a Traffic Regulation Order should be implemented on the following grounds:

- For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians) and;
- For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
- For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road to which the order relates or any other road, or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising

As part of our key actions outlined in the Air Quality Action Plan, we want to encourage residents of Leicester to invest in Electric Vehicles. As a result, new EV Charging bays will be installed on street to provide short term charging facilities in the city centre.

The opportunity is also being taken to propose amendments to regularise various traffic movements on Charles Street.
