LEICESTER ORDER 2024**


The above Order was made on 26th June 2024. The effect of the order will be to stop up the footpath known as Packwood Road Footpath running from Marwood Road to Packwood Road and create an alternative highway running from Marwood Road to Packwood Road.

If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
