

**THE LEICESTER (CONSOLIDATION) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2006  
(AMENDMENT) (ST PETERS ESTATE DROPPED KERBS) (No.3\*\*) ORDER 2025**

**Statement of Reasons**

Further to an inquiry from the Housing Department & Waste Management regarding difficulties with refuse collections from various bin stores on the St Peters estate in Wycliffe Ward. A patch-walk survey was carried out to identify the problem locations, where dropped kerbs that service the bin stores can be blocked by parked vehicles.

Please see the attached plan which shows proposals to implement additional double yellow line 'no waiting at any time' parking restrictions across the dropped kerb accesses (shown by the thick black lines on the plan) to address this issue. The no double yellow line proposals are shown by the green lines on the plan, & will cover dropped kerb accesses on Apollo Court, Berners Street, Jupiter Close, Pluto Close, Pegasus Close, Polaris Close, Taurus Close & Vostock Close.

In addition, some more extensive lengths of double yellow line 'no waiting at any time' parking restrictions (also shown in green) are proposed on Atlas Close, Pegasus Close & Vostock Close to help to maintain access, in particular for emergency & refuse collection vehicles).

Existing double & single yellow lines in the immediate area are also shown on the plan, in brown, orange & light blue.

The formal reason for the proposals is for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the roads run.
