THE LEICESTER (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (HOME FARM AREA) ORDER 2025

Leicester City Council (the Council) in exercise of their powers under Sections 84(1) and 84(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act) and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Leicester (20 mph speed limit) (Home Farm Area) Order 2025 and shall come into force on TBC 2025.
- 2. No person shall cause or permit a motor vehicle to exceed the speed of 20 miles per hour in the following roads: -
