Leicester City Council (Dover Street Off-Street Car Park) (Electric Charging Bay) (Consolidation Order Amendment No.1) Order 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** Leicester City Council proposes to make an Order under Section 32, 35 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of this Order will be to amend the parking bays already in place within the car park listed below, by way of amendment to the Leicester (Off-Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2024, together with the changes and additions as set out below:

To amend the existing off street car parking Order as detailed below;

## **Dover Street Car park**

- 1. To provide Electric Vehicle Charging Bays within the car park.
- 2. To introduce new definitions;

"Electric Vehicle" means a motor vehicle which is propelled by electric energy (batteryonly powered vehicle) from rechargeable batteries. The batteries provide the power to propel the vehicle and to power the lights and all accessories within the vehicle. A plugin hybrid vehicle which requires charging is also included in this category.

"Electric Vehicle Charging point" means a Parking Place designated for use by an electric vehicle whilst charging its power supply and is still subject to the Charging Hours.

3. Within the Principal Order, Schedule 2 will be amended for Dover Street Car Park to include "Electric Vehicle Charging"

Please note all other existing restrictions on the above-mentioned car park remains unchanged.
